




To develop the 2022-2027 Strategic Plan, we engaged in a year-long process of analysis, dialogue and community consultation. Students, parents/guardians, staff, the WSÁNEĆ First Nation and other community members came together to provide input and insights resulting in the identification of four Strategic Plan priorities – Literacy, Indigenous Learner Success, Mental Health and Wellness, and Citizenship.

These goals will remain consistent over the 5-year life of the plan, while also remaining flexible due to emerging information. This will allow the plan to be responsive and adaptable to changes within our Saanich Schools community.

The Strategic Plan XĆI¢ESTEN


