PRELIMINARY ENROLLMENT PROJECTIONS SEPT 2022

SANICH

- Elementary and Middle neighbourhood enrollment is trending above forecast
 - ≈ 60 FTE
 - ► A division added at both Brentwood and Bayside prior to September start-up
- Secondary enrollment is trending closer to forecast
 - Uncertain until final course count at the end of September
- Enrollment will be confirmed with 1701 submission in early October

 - Bachelor of Education


