PRELIMINARY ENROLLMENT PROJECTIONS SEPT 2022

- ▶ Elementary and Middle neighbourhood enrollment is trending above forecast
 - ▶ ≈ 60 FTE
 - ▶ A division added at both Brentwood and Bayside prior to September start-up
- ▶ Secondary enrollment is trending closer to forecast
 - ▶ Uncertain until final course count at the end of September
- ▶ Enrollment will be confirmed with 1701 submission in early October



STAFFING START-UP SNAPSHOT

Teaching & Support Staff (June - Sept 2022)

- ▶ 289 Teacher postings
- ▶ 66 TTOC's hired
- ▶ Currently reviewing 30+ teacher applications
- ▶ 115 CUPE postings
- ▶ New support staff hires include:
 - ▶ 24 EAs (7 from EACS)
 - ▶ 4 clerical
 - ▶ 4 bus drivers
 - ▶ 3 trades
 - ▶ 3 custodians

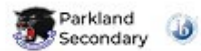
