Subject: Approval of Board Orientation Program Date: December 1, 2022

Purpose and Background

The purpose of this briefing is to facilitate the Board's review and approval of the Board Orientation Program.

The Board's <u>Annual Work Plan</u> includes that in September the Board will: "In an election year – approve orientation program for trustees following the Board elections."

A draft orientation program was presented in September 2022 (see attachment 1). At the September 21, 2022 Regular Board meeting the Board approved that the following orientation commence in November following the election subject to confirmation by the newly elected Board, under the overarching theme for student success:

- 1. What is Governance Channels of Communication
- 2. Board/Trustee Operations and Administration
- 3. Budget Context and Risk Management
- 4. Indigenous Student Success (Local Education Agreement)
- 5. Ed Tech
- 6. Parental Rights
- 7. Inclusive Education Designations / Ministry Funding / Student Supports
- 8. Individual Learning Centre (ILC) programming
- 9. Evidence-based Practices

At the October 26, 2022 Regular Board meeting, the Board approved that the Board planning day on December 8, 2022 be used for the first two trustee orientation sessions on "What is Governance" including student success and "Board/Trustee Operations and Administration" subject to consultation by the Superintendent, Secretary Treasurer, Board Chair and the three trustees elect.

A draft outline of the topics to be covered during the December 8, 2022 Board Planning Day have been shared with the newly elected trustees, and their feedback will be reflected in the final Board Planning Day agenda.



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Next Steps

The next step is for the newly elected Board to approve the orientation program. Approval of this orientation program does not preclude the Board from including additional topic areas in the future as required.

Purpose and Background
