

5 FACTORS THAT MATTER MOST

1. EXPLICIT INCLUSIVITY

- Inclusive school climate essential for those historically marginalized
- Celebrating diversity isn't enough

2. STRONG RELATIONSHIPS

 Balance high expectations with empathy – listen, use humour, foster dialogue, and show interest in students

3. COMPREHENSIVE LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES

- Instruction that promotes complex thinking over memorization
- Collaborative, interdisciplinary, active and problem-based learning

4. TRACKING & TRANSITIONS

Monitoring attendance and achievement over time

5. FLEXIBLE SYSTEMS

Systems that allow for various completion options
