1. CALL TO ORDER AND WELCOME

Moved by TRUSTEE ELDER

Seconded by TRUSTEE SILZER

That the Board request senior staff to prepare a balanced budget for consideration by the Board at the May 17, 2023 meeting, reflecting the following principles:

- 1. That the 2023/24 Preliminary Budget be balanced without reflecting program budget reductions by allocating to the extent necessary: contingency reserve, and to the extent possible underspend of 2022/23 service and supply budgets.
- 2. That program budgets not be increased beyond the essential inflationary adjustments already reflected in the calculated net unfunded inflationary pressure of \$1,683,000.
- 3. That during 2023/24 any additional funding, including from enrolment growth relative to forecast, be applied to reduce budget pressure to the extent possible.

CARRIED.

Moved by TRUSTEE ELDER

Seconded by TRUSTEE VANWELL

That the district conduct a review of programs, early in 2023/24, considering where budget reductions are feasible to inform cost reduction measures to be implemented in future budgets as required, and

That the Board advocate at all levels for funding of inflationary and other unfunded cost pressures.
