Code talkers were First Nations soldiers in World War II who spoke Cree. They were the Canadian military's secret weapon.



Code talkers were sworn to secrecy about their jobs. Because of that, no one really knows much about who they were.

All of the Indigenous code talkers from Canada have now passed on. It would be great for these heroes to be posthumously recognized.


