
- ▶ 290 postings for Sept 2019

- ▶ 2019/20 ≈ 133 teachers + 12 in-progress

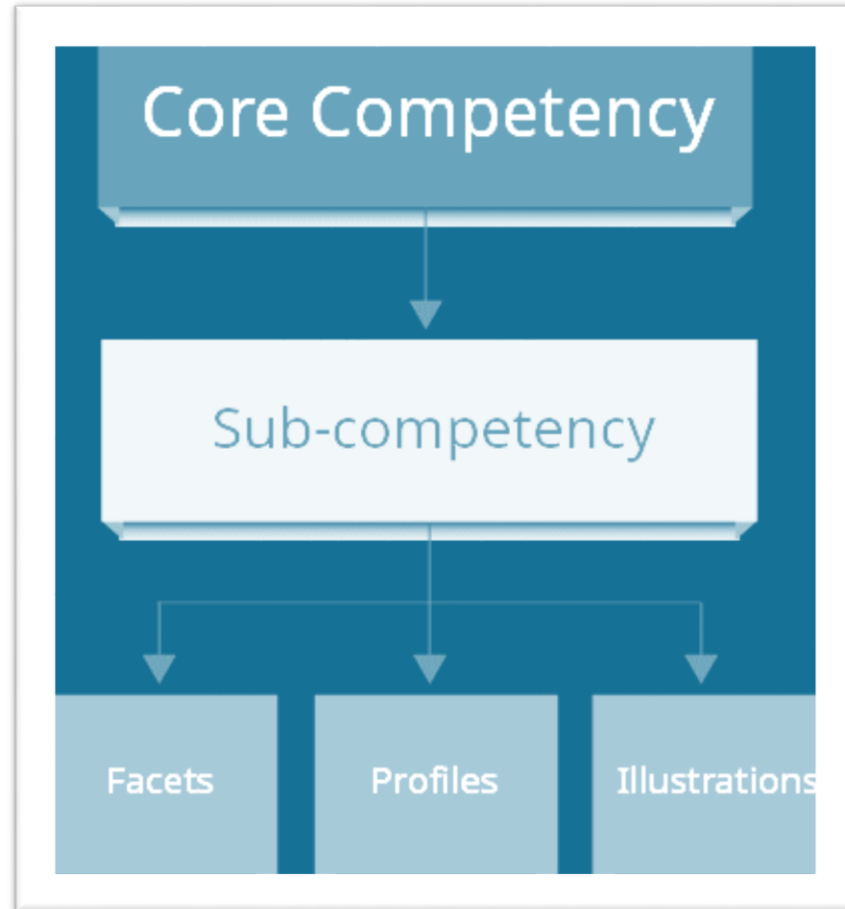

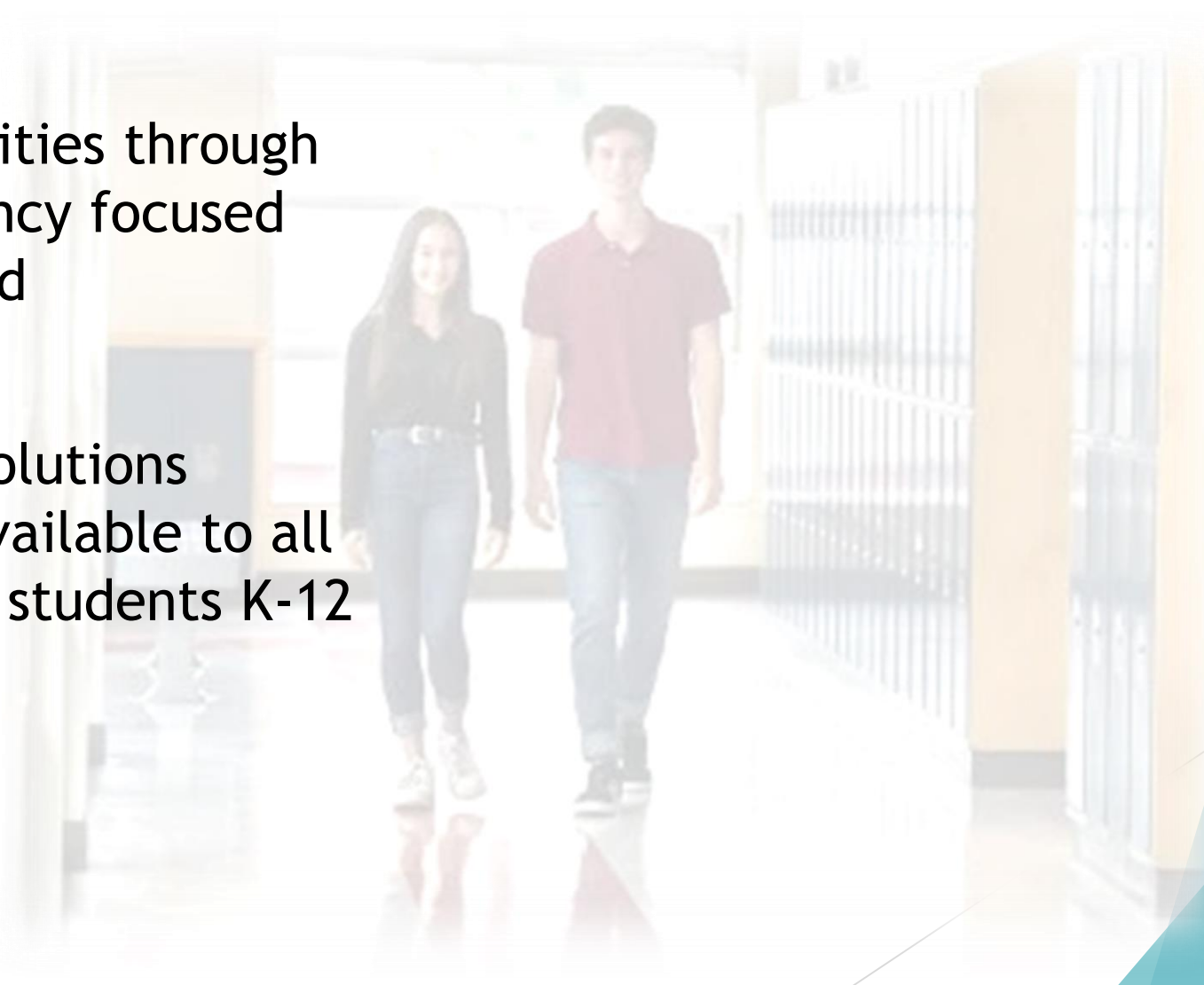
# Gr 11/12 Curriculum Implementation

- ▶ Looking for solutions universally available to all teachers and students K-12



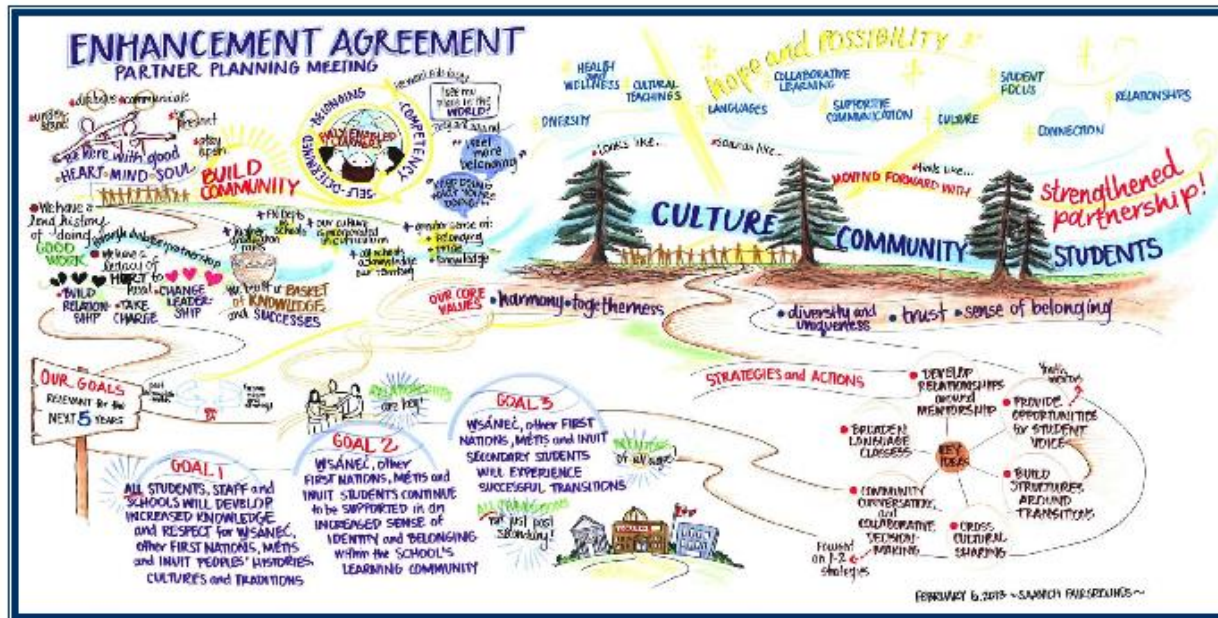

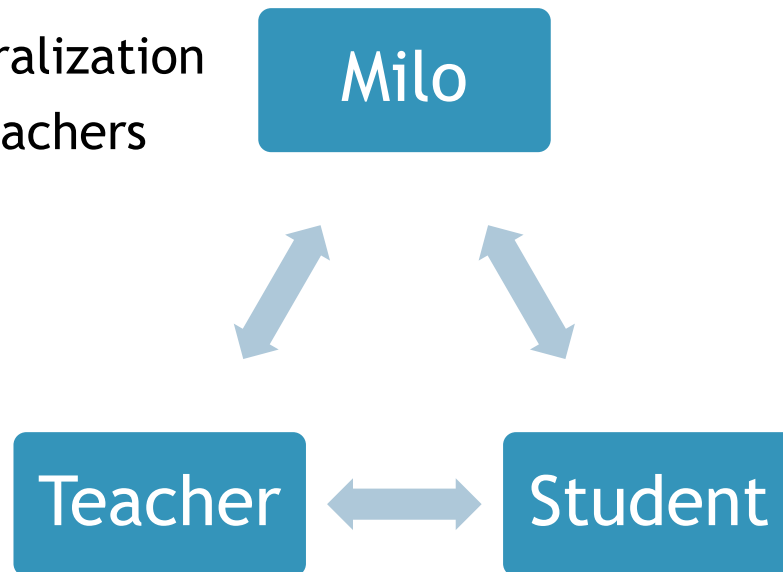
# Competency Based IEP
