By the Numbers - Since our Last IT Update in Feb 2020

We have deployed 1200 machines over the past year:


- Laptops to school including laptops available for TTOCs when at the school and Student Teachers on practicum
- Desktop devices for students in the secondary schools
- Laptops for students in elementary schools and middle schools
- Purchased and deploying 18 mobile carts of devices
- Mobile devices at sites help ensure readiness if we need to go to Remote Learning again

Getting to Yes



- ► Enabling IT to provide timely and relevant support to district staff
- Providing teachers with the tools for teaching, assessing and reporting that are aligned and vetted.

- Currently deploying 57 Classroom iPads to schools to support CSL
- Using FreshGrade and interactive document cameras to collect evidence of student learning
- Organizing a working group in Jan 2021 to explore future digital portfolio platforms

- Currently working with several schools to build and validate resources
- Taking lessons learned back to the EdTech Team (Feb 2021) for further discussion into a district platform
